Subject: Announcement of Sanctions Against the Russian Federation

Dear Members of Congress and Public,

Last night, the Russian President Putin recognized separatist regions of Ukraine as independent republics, and sent in so-called "peacekeeping" forces into Ukrainian territory. This is a clear beginning of an invasion into Ukraine's borders. In response to this I have authorized sanctions against any business or operation with connections with the Russian government or military. We must not allow unprovoked aggression and invasion. From now on any citizen of Soundland will not be able to do business with any organization that has direct links to the Russian government or military, including third party groups controlled in part by said parties. Citizens must not buy, sell, invest, deal or collaborate with said companies or groups. More sanctions will come if Russia continues its move into Ukraine. Today we stand with Ukraine against Russian aggravation.
