Annex land to be incorporated into the Republic of Soundland as a Territorial state

Be it enacted by the National Senate of the Republic of Soundland,

Short Title: The Bill Point Annexation Act

Section 1:

The intent of this bill is to direct and proclaim the orderly annexation of designated foreign territories into the political union and territorial boundaries of the Republic of Soundland.

Section 2:

The Republic of Soundland shall annex a contiguous area situated within the Bill Point region to be incorporated as a Territorial state into the political union of the Republic of Soundland.

Section 3:

The boundaries of the annexation are to be defined as the borders negotiated between the Soundland citizens residing within such area and the president, detailed in the survey document titled "The Negotiated Annexation Boundaries of the Proposed Territorial State of Bill Point" published by the Office of the President and provided to the National Senate.

Section 4:

Physical notices of the annexation and of the borders of the Bill Point territorial state are to be posted in the locality of the area to be annexed for not less than one week time upon the passage of this bill and its signature by the president.

Section 5:

The formal annexation of the said territory and the assumption of Soundlandian territorial and political jurisdiction over such area shall take effect one week after its passage and signing by the President of the Republic of Soundland.
